The Dark Autumn palette is spiced, lush, textured, and opulent.


## THE FEELING:

Imagine sitting atop a desert sand dune of ochre and gold, overlooking a rare verdant oasis, while enjoying the last of a Moroccan sunset; or savouring a jammy Pinot Noir, rich with notes of plum, in the comfort of a vintage, cognac leather club chair placed perfectly by a slow burning fire of red hot embers on a chilly afternoon; or the shaded serenity of a waterfall deep in the woods pouring into a pool below, naturally coloured by the iron and tannins of the surrounding moss-covered rock.

## COLOUR CHARACTERISTICS:

Hue: All colour families are represented in all seasons. Your best versions of red, yellow, green, blue, and purple are determined by the temperature, value, saturation, and intensity as follows.

Temperature: Warm Neutral; a hint of cool  
Value: Medium to Dark  
Saturation: High, Shaded (mixed with black)  
Intensity: Deep, Rich



## IMAGE:

High intensity, low to medium contrast, dark, dramatic, elegant, rich, and powerful

## COLOUR CHARACTERISTICS TO AVOID:

Muted; Soft; Cool; Bright

## JEWELLERY:

Metals in matte gold, antique gold, brass, copper, and bronze  
Natural materials, such as wood, tortoise shell, pearls in cream  
Gemstones in natural stones that blend with your colour palette
